Up until now, this data has been recorded and maintained in paper “leader’s books.” Similar to the “day-timers” carried by business professionals, the leader’s book system of information management requires repetitive data manual entry and is difficult to share among leaders. And it is subject to being lost or damaged during the rigors of military life. Small unit leaders spend up to eight hours per week maintaining routine data records, sharing data, and writing reports, keeping them from other more important mission-critical military responsibilities.

The Leader’s eBook, developed by Warrior Solutions, Inc., provides a unique solution to the problem of organizing and maintaining routine small unit data in the military. The Leader’s eBook is software that runs on both personal digital assistants (PDAs) from major vendors such as, Hewlett Packard, Dell, Palm and others; and synchronizes with software running on standard Wintel desktop computers, laptops, and tablet PCs. This allows information to be entered in the office, in the field, and wherever small unit leaders are working. Data is quickly synchronized between PC and PDA. The Leader’s eBook reduces the weight of a traditional paper leader’s book from three to five pounds to the negligible weight of a single PDA. Using the Leader’s eBook, small unit leaders typically reduce routine administration chores by four to eight hours each week
